## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

### Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic

#### Various Roads In Chester

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of roads in Chester to enable a crane to be dismantled and a foul sewer connection to be made at the Travelodge Site.

- (1) Delamere Street, Chester - temporary closure from the junction of Upper Northgate Street to the junction of Victoria Road
- (2) Victoria Road, Chester - Suspension of a one way traffic order from its junction with Delamere Street to the junction of George Street - The City of Chester (Upper Northgate Street area) (Traffic Management) Order 1994
- (3) Brook Street, Chester - Suspension of the bus lane order from the Inner Ring Road to Gorse Stacks - The City of Chester (Frodsham Street) (One Way Traffic and Bus Lane) Order 2002

The Order will come into force on Sunday 16 May 2010 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately two days to complete.

#### Alternative routes for through traffic

Traffic should proceed via St Oswalds Way, Brook Street, Gorse Stacks and Victoria Road.

## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

### Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic

#### Hollins Hill In Chester

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of road, in Chester to enable Water Mains Rehabilitation works to be carried out.

- (1) Hollins Hill from junction of Knights Lane to junction of Utkinton Lane.

The Order will come into force on Monday 17th May 2010 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately twenty nine days to complete.

Alternative routes for through traffic.

Traffic should proceed via Utkinton Lane, Stable Lane, Hollins Hill from B5152 Fishpool Road to Knights Lane.

## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

### (The Deva Triathlon) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2010

Notice is hereby given that Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council has made an Order in accordance with the provisions of Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect will be to prohibit vehicular traffic on the following road in the Handbridge area to enable the Deva Triathlon to take place on Sunday 6th June 2010: -

Hartington Street, Handbridge from its junction with Pretoria Street to its junction with Appleyards Lane

The closure of the above road will come into operation at 08:00 hours and will last for a maximum duration of 3½/hours. The alternative route for through traffic is via Appleyards Lane, Cross Hey and Meadows Lane.

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the road will be maintained at all times.

## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

### Temporary Restriction Of Traffic

#### Canal Street In The City Of Chester

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council has made an Order the effect of which is to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of road to enable gas main renewal works to be carried out by North West Gas Alliance. The Order continues the restrictions originally imposed on 8 May by means of an emergency notice.

- (1) Canal Street, Chester – One Way Restriction (no access eastwards from Garden Lane to Upper Northgate Street).

The Order will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which are being carried out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 June 2010.

Alternative routes for eastbound traffic

Traffic should proceed via One Way system, lane closure on George Street with one way from Upper Northgate Street to Raymond Street. Diversion via Raymond Street, Bouverie Street, Chichester Street, Parkgate Road, Liverpool Road Fountains Round-a-bout then Upper Northgate Street. During the two weekends when Delamere Street is closed they will be diverted from fountains to St Martin's Way, Frodsham Street and Gorse Stacks.
