Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych wedi gwneud Gorchymyn sy'n gwahardd unrhyw gerbyd rhag defnyddio'r hyd hwnnw o Chapel Street Dinbych yn Sir Ddinbych sy'n ymestyn o'i chyffordd â Stryd y Dyffryn i gyfeiriad y gogledd orllewin am bellter o oddeutu 50 metr.

Y rheswm am y cau yw hwyloso gwaith cynnal adeiladau gan E H Aluminium Ltd.

Y llwybr gwahanol sydd ar gael i draffig yw drwy Stryd y Dyffryn, Post Office Lane, Beacons Hill a Chapel Street, ac fe fydd yna arwyddbyst i'r perwyl hwnnw. Fe gedwir mynediad i gerddwyr drwy gydol cyfnod y cau.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar Fai 31 2010, a bydd yn dal mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd gwblhau'r gwaith pa un bynnag yw'r cynharaf. Rhagwelir y bydd y gwaith yn cymryd oddeutu 1 wythnos i'w gwblhau.

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order which prohibits any vehicle from using that length of Chapel Street Denbigh in the County of Denbigh which extends from its junction with Vale Street in a north westerly direction for a distance of approximately 50 metres

The reason for the closure is to facilitate building maintenance works by E H Aluminium Ltd.

The alternative route available for traffic is via Vale Street, Post Office Lane, Beacons Hill and Chapel Street, and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order comes into force on 31 May 2010, and will remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 1 week to complete.
