ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

SECTION 14(1)

**The County Borough of Conwy (Conway Road
Colwyn Bay) (Temporary Prohibition of
Through Traffic) Order 2010**

NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Conwy County Borough Council has made an Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in an easterly direction in that length of Conway Road Colwyn Bay, from its junction with Gregory Avenue to its junction with Brompton Avenue.

The Order is necessary to facilitate streetlighting upgrade work.

The alternative route is via Conway Road to Black Cat Roundabout, A55 to Brompton Avenue slip road and will be signposted accordingly.

The Order comes into effect on 7 June 2010. It is anticipated that the road will be closed for a maximum period of 2 weeks, or until the works which it is proposed to carry out thereon has been completed subject to a maximum period of 2 months.
