RHODDIR RHYBUDD bod Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy wedi gwneud Gorchymyn, i wahardd unrhyw gerddwr rhag mynd ar hyd y darn hwnnw o Llwybr Troed 15 yng Nghymuned Dolwyddelan yn dechrau ar Ffordd Ty Mawr Wybrnant yng nghyfeirnod grid SH 7763 5325 ac yn mynd i gyfeiriad y de am oddeutu 120m i ffin y gymuned wrth Afon Wybrnant yng nghyfeirnod grid SH 7767 5315 a rhan o Llwybr Troed 2 yn dechrau o ffin y gymuned wrth Afon Wybrnant a mynd i gyfeiriad y dwyrain am oddeutu 50m gôn offen ar ei gyffordd efo llwybr troed 3 Bro Machno ym Mwrdeistref Sirol Conwy yng nghyfeirnod grid SH 7771 5314.

Mae angen y Gorchymyn oherwydd y tebygrwydd o berygl i'r cyhoedd oherwydd y bont sydd ddim yn ddiogel. Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 24 Mehefin 2010. Disgwylir y bydd y llwybr droed ar gau am gyfnod o ddim mwy na 6 mis.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

SECTION 14(1)

The County Borough of Conwy (Footpath 15 in the Community of Dolwyddelan and part of Footpath 2 in the Community of Bro Machno)

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians)

Order 2010

NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Conwy County Borough Council has made an Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any pedestrian to proceed in that length of Footpath 15 in the Community of Dolwyddelan commencing at Ty Mawr Wybrnant Road at grid reference SH 7763 5325 and proceeding in a southerly direction for approximately 120m to the community boundary at the Afon Wybrnant at grid reference SH 7767 5315 and part of Footpath 2 commencing at the community boundary at Afon Wybrnant and proceeding in an easterly direction for approximately 50m and ending at its junction with footpath 3 Bro Machno in the County Borough of Conwy at grid reference SH 7771 5314.

The Order is necessary for the reason of likelihood of danger to the public due to unsafe bridge.

The Order will come into effect on 24 June 2010. It is anticipated that the footpath will be closed for a maximum period of 6 months.
