**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic**

## **Chester Road in the Parish of Hatton in Chester**

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of road, in the Parish of Hatton, in Chester to enable carriageway resurfacing and haunching works to be carried out.

- (1) Chester Road, Hatton from the junction with Whitchurch Road to junction with Gatesheath Lane

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to the lengths of road or in connection with agriculture, building construction, works of repair and the like or use in an emergency of vehicles for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes. A through route will not always be available and any vehicles not requiring access to properties on the length of road should use the alternative routes.

The Order will come into force on Monday 19 July 2010 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately two weeks to complete.

### **Alternative routes for through traffic**

Traffic should proceed via: Chester bound, Tattenhall Road; High Street; Rocky Lane (The Righi) and the A41.

Tattenhall bound, A41; Frog Lane; High Street and Tattenhall Road.

Due to the narrow widths of Frog Lane and Rocky Lane it is necessary to make these one-way as follows:

Frog Lane: Closed to traffic travelling west between Covert Rise and A41.

Rocky Lane (The Righi): Closed to traffic travelling north between A41 and High Street.

Access with short delays maintained for residents and businesses.
