NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 14th July, 2010, to make an Order which will prohibit any vehicle from using that length of Unclassified road known as the alley at the rear of Church Street and Russell Road, Rhyl in the County of Denbigh, for its entire length.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate building works by Denbighshire County Council – Public Protection.

The Order will come into force on 2nd August 2010 and remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately three months to complete.
