Y rheswm am y cau yw hwyluso ailosod pont droed.

Mae'r Gorchymyn cyfredol yn dod i ben ar Awst 8fed 2010, ond i hwyluso parhad y gwaith mae wedi ei ymestyn o gyfnod o 6 mis pellach tan Chwefror 8fed 2011, gyda chymeradwyaeth Cynulliad Cenedlaethol Cymru gan ddefnyddio ei bwerau dan adran 15(5) Deddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd (fel y'i diwygiwyd gan Ddeddf Traffig Ffyrdd (Cyfyngiadau Dros Dro) 1991).

Nid oes yna unrhyw lwybr gwahanol ar gael, a'r mynediad agosaf i gerddwyr fyddai dros y bont ffordd bresennol.

**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER

PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 32 PRESTATYN
NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

On 8th February 2010, Denbighshire County Council made an order effective for a six month period which prohibits pedestrians from using Public Footpath No. 32 in the community of Prestatyn.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate the replacement of the footbridge.

The current Order expires on 8th August 2010, but to facilitate the continuation of the works this has been extended by a further 6 month period until 8th February 2011, with the approval of the National Assembly for Wales using its powers under section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991).

There is no alternative route available, and the nearest pedestrian access would be over the existing road bridge.
