**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 16(A)**  
**AS AMENDED**

**BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994**

**The County Borough of Conwy**  
**(Llandudno Celtic Winter Fayre)**  
**(Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic)**  
**Order 2010**

NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Conwy County Borough Council with the consent of the Welsh Ministers, intend to make an Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The Order is necessary to allow the Llandudno Development Partnership to hold the Llandudno Celtic Winter Fayre from 16 November – 22 November 2010.

All alternative routes will be signposted and pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of the event.

The Order will come into effect at 6pm on 16 November 2010. The lengths of road will be closed to vehicular traffic for 6 days, or until the event which it is proposed to be held thereon has ended, whichever is the earlier.

**Lengths of Road in Llandudno in the**

Madoc Street: from its junction with Stephen Street to its junction with Lloyd Street

Zion Passage: from its junction with Madoc Street and its junction with Back Madoc Street
