Mae Cynghor Sir Ddinbych yn bwriadu, yn ddim cynt na 7 diwrnod o Orffennaf 28ain 2010, gwneud Gorchymyn a fydd yn gwahardd unrhyw gerbyd rhag defnyddio'r hyd hwnnw o Hottia Lane Dyserth, yn Sir Ddinbych am ei hyd cyfan.

Y rheswm am y cau yw hwyluso gwaith ail-wynebu gan Gyngor Sir Ddinbych - Cynnal.

Y llwybr gwahanol fydd ar gael i draffig fydd drwy Ffordd Llanelwy, Ffordd Cwm, A5151 Bodrhyddan Hall i'r gyffordd gyferbyn â Bryn Fynnon Cottages yna i'r Tŷ Gwyn, a chroesffordd Erw Wen, ac fe fydd yna arwyddbyst i'r perwyl hwnnw. Fe gynhelir mynediad i gerddwyr drwy gydol cyfnod y cau.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar Awst 16eg 2010 a bydd yn dal mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd gwblhau'r gwaith pa un bynnag yw'r cynharaf. Rhagwelir y cymer y gwaith oddeutu pythefnos i'w gwblhau.

**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER**

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 28th July 2010 to make an Order which will prohibit any vehicle from using that length of Hottia Lane Dyserth, in the County of Denbigh for its entire length

The reason for the closure is to facilitate resurfacing works for Denbighshire County Council - Maintenance.

The alternative route available for traffic will be via St. Asaph Road, Cwm Road, A5151 Bodrhyddan Hall to the junction opposite Bryn Fynnon Cottages then to Ty Gwyn, and Erw Wen to crossroads, and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order will come into force on 16th August, 2010 and remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately two weeks to complete.
