Mae Cynghor Sir Ddinbych wedi gwneud Gorchymyn sy'n gwahardd unrhyw gerbyd rhag defnyddio'r hyd hwnnw o Fwlch Penbarras Llanbedr, yn Sir Ddinbych, sy'n ymestyn o faes parcio Moel Famau i gyfeiriad y gogledd orllewin am hyd o oddeutu 33 metr.

Y rheswm am y cau yw hwyluso gwelliannau draenio, ail-wynebu a ffurfio cloddiau pridd ag wyneb carreg yn rhan o Brosiect y Grug a'r Caerau gan Wasanaethau Cefn Gwlad Cynghor Sir Ddinbych.

Bydd y llwybr arall sydd ar gael i draffig ar hyd Fwlch Penbarras, Penbarras Lodge i Dafarn y Gelyn, A494 Rhuthun, Lôn Cae Glas a Bwlch Penbarras ac fe fydd yna arwyddbyst i'r perwyl hwnnw. Fe gedwir mynediad i gerddwyr drwy gydol cyfnod y cau.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar ddydd Mawrth Awst 3ydd, 2010 a bydd yn dal mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd gwblhau'r gwaith pa un bynnag yw'r cynharaf.. Rhagwelir y cymer y gwaith oddeutu 6 wythnos i'w gwblhau.

**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER**

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order which prohibits any vehicle from using that length of Bwlch Penbarras Llanbedr, in the County of Denbigh, which extends from Moel Famau car park in a north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 33 metres.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate drainage improvements resurfacing and formation of stone faced earth banks as part of the Heather and Hillforts Project by Denbighshire County Council Countryside Services.

The alternative route available for traffic is via Bwlch Penbarras, Penbarras Lodge to Tafarn y Gelyn, A494 Ruthin, Lon Cae Glas and Bwlch Penbarras and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order comes into force on Tuesday 3rd August 2010, and will remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 6 weeks to complete
