Y rheswm am y cau yw hwyluso gwaith ailwynebu gan Gyngor Sir Ddinbych - Cynnal.

Y ffordd wahanol sydd ar gael i draffig fydd drwy Trellewelyn Road, Grosvenor Avenue a Dyserth Road, a byddant ag arwyddbyst i'r perwyl hwnnw. Fe gedwir mynediad i gerddwyr drwy gydol cyfnod y cau.

**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 18th August 2010 to make an Order which will prohibit any vehicle from using that length of Pen y Maes Avenue Rhyl, in the County of Denbigh, which extends from its junction with Dyserth road to its junction with Trellewelyn Road.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate resurfacing works by Denbighshire County Council - Maintenance.

The alternative route available for traffic will be via, Trellewelyn Road, Grosvenor Avenue and Dyserth Road, and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order will come into force on 4th September, 2010 and remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take place on Saturday and Sunday 4th & 5th September 2010 and Saturday and Sunday 11th & 12th September 2010.
