Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Temporary Prohibition Of Waiting Order

Brookdale Place In The City Of Chester

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit waiting on the following length of road, in the City of Chester to enable Cheshire West and Chester Council to carry out repairs to the retaining walls/ planters at Hoole Way Roundabout Subway.

(1) Brookdale Place – Prohibit waiting at any time on easterly and northerly sides – from a point 10 metres south of its northerly end for a distance of 26 metres in a northerly then westerly direction.

The Order will come into force on Monday 30 August 2010 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately three weeks to complete.

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

(Cambrian Community Festival) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2010

Notice is hereby given that Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council has made an Order in accordance with the provisions of Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect will be to prohibit vehicular traffic on the following roads in the Garden Quarter of Chester to enable the Cambrian Community Festival to take place on Saturday 18th September 2010: -

Gladstone Road - whole length

Granville Road - whole length

Upper Cambrian Road - Gladstone Rd to 10 metres north of Cambrian Rd

The closure of the above roads will come into operation at 06:00 hours and will last for a maximum duration of 24 hours. The alternative route for through traffic is via Stadium Way, Sealand Road and South View Road.

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times.

Traffic Regulation Orders

NOTICE is hereby given that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council proposes to make the following Traffic Regulation Order in accordance with the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

(A41 Ring Road, Chester)

(Restriction Of Waiting In Lay-Bys) Order 2010

The effect of the Order will be to restrict waiting to 2 hours, return prohibited within 6 hours on the following lengths of road:

Lay-by on the west side of A41 Ring Road located between its junctions with Hoole Lane and the A56 Hoole Road Roundabout

Lay-by on the east side of A41 Ring Road located between its junctions with Guilden Sutton Lane and the A56 Hoole Road Roundabout

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a plan showing the extent of the proposals, may be examined at the Parking Services Office, 1st Floor, The Forum, Chester between the hours of 9am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order, or to any provisions contained in it, you may do so in writing specifying the grounds on which it is made, to the undersigned by 10th September 2010.
