

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council

(Off-Street Parking Places, Ellesmere Port) (Variation) Order 2010

NOTICE is hereby given that on 12 August 2010 Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council made the above named Order in exercise of their powers under Sections 32 and 35 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers. The Order will come into force on 31 August 2010.

The effect of the Order will be to reduce the area of the Town Centre car park by 64 spaces as a result of development at The Port Arcades and to re-introduce provisions in relation to pick up points and loading/unloading areas.

A copy of the Order may be examined at the Parking Services Office, 1st Floor, The Forum, Chester between the hours of 9am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or any provisions contained therein, on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instruments made under it have not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within six weeks from 12 August 2010 apply to the High Court for that purpose.
