Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych yn bwriadu, yn ddim cynt na 7 diwrnod o Awst 25, 2010 gwneud Gorchymyn a fydd yn gwahardd unrhyw gerbyd rhag defnyddio'r hyd hwnnw o Ffordd Penrhwylyfa Gallt Melyd yn Sir Ddinbych, sy'n ymestyn o'i chyffordd â Ffordd Talargoch i gyfeiriad y gogledd orllewin am bellter o oddeutu 586 metr.

Y rheswm am y cau yw hwyluso gwaith ailwynebu gan Gyngor Sir Ddinbych - Cynnal.

Y ffordd wahanol sydd ar gael i draffig fydd ar hyd Ffordd Isa, Ffordd Pendyffryn a'r A547 Ffordd Meliden, a byddant ag arwyddbyst i'r perwyl hwnnw. Fe gynhelir mynediad i gerddwyr drwy gydol cyfnod y cau.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar Fedi 13, 2010 a bydd yn dal mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd gwblhau'r gwaith pa un bynnag yw'r cynharaf. Rhagwelir y bydd y gwaith yn cymryd oddeutu pythefnos i'w gwblhau.

**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 25th August 2010 to make an Order which will prohibit any vehicle from using that length of Ffordd Penrhwylyfa Meliden, in the County of Denbigh, which extends from its junction with Ffordd Talargoch in a north westerly direction for a distance of approximately 586 metres.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate resurfacing works by Denbighshire County Council - Maintenance.

The alternative route available for traffic will be via Ffordd Isa, Ffordd Pendyffryn and A547 Meliden Road, and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order will come into force on 13th September 2010 and remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 2 weeks to complete.
