Mae Cynghor Sir Ddinbych yn bwriadu gwneud Gorchymyn dan Adrannau 1(1) a (2), 2(1) i (3) a 4(2) a (3), 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 52 a 124 Deddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984, ac effaith hynny fydd gwahardd cerbydau rhag aros ar yr hydoedd hynny o ffordd a nodir yn yr Atodlen isod.

**DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
NOTICE OF PERMANENT PROHIBITION
(BULL LANE, DENBIGH)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 201 .
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

Denbighshire County Council propose to make an Order under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and (3), 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 52 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule below.

Exceptions will be provided in the proposed Order to permit waiting in the lengths of road referred to in the Schedule for the purposes of alighting, boarding, loading and unloading, and works of maintenance, repair and the like.

Exceptions will also be provided in the proposed Order to allow vehicles displaying both a Disabled Person's Badge and a Disabled Person's Parking Disc to wait in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule of the proposed Order for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same day).

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the lengths of road to which the proposed Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at Denbigh Library, Hall Square, Denbigh and at the offices of the undersigned during normal office hours. Objections to the proposed Order, together with the grounds on which they are made, should be sent in writing to the undersigned by 24 September 2010.
