Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic

C212 Pool Lane In The Parish Of Elton In Chester

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of road, in the Parish of Elton in Chester to enable Network Rail to carry out railway bridge repair works.

(1) C212 Pool Lane, Elton at Railway Bridge 20 (junction with Elton New Road Roundabout)

The works will be taking place between the hours of 2200 hrs and 0600 hrs (Monday to Friday nights).

The Order will come into force on Monday 13 September 2010 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately two weeks to complete.

Traffic should proceed via A5117 Shotwick By Pass, C211 Ince Lane, C211 Station Road and C212 Pool Lane

Ux1254 Along The Rear Of Northgate Street In

The City Of Chester

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of road, in the City of Chester to enable Colin Jones Roofing Ltd to erect scaffolding in order to complete urgent building works.

(1) Along the rear of Northgate Street from its junction with Hamilton Place to its junction with Goss Street

The Order will come into force on Monday 06 September 2010 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately three weeks to complete.

Alternative routes for through traffic

Traffic should proceed via Hamilton Place, Goss Street.
