ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

CHURCH STREET IN THE PARISH OF TARVIN IN CHESTER

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of road, in the Parish of Tarvin, in Chester to enable carriageway resurfacing to be carried out by BAM Nuttall.

(1) Church Street from its junction with High Street to its junction with Broomheath Lane

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to the lengths of road or in connection with agriculture, building construction, works of repair and the like or use in an emergency of vehicles for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes. A through route will not always be available and any vehicles not requiring access to properties on the length of road should use the alternative routes.

The Order will come into force on Tuesday 2 November 2010 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding five days or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately five days to complete.

Alternative routes for through traffic

Traffic should proceed via High Street, Hockenhull Lane, Heath Drive and Broomheath Lane

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

VICARS LANE IN CHESTER

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of road, in Chester to enable W E Parsons to carry out landscaping works.

(1) Vicars Lane, Chester from its junction with Love Street to its junction with Little John Street - traffic will be prevented from travelling in a westerly direction

The works will be taking place between the hours of 0800 hours and 1800 hours on (Sunday 7 November and Sunday 14 November) and between the hours of 1800 and 2200 hours on (Monday 8 November and Monday 15 November) and (Tuesday 9 November) 1800 to 2200 (provisional)

The Order will come into force on Sunday 7 November 2010 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately nine days to complete.

Alternative routes for through traffic

Traffic should proceed via:

Love Street, Foregate Street, City Road roundabout, St Oswald's Way, St Martins Way, Nicholas Street, Grosvenor Street, Pepper Street and Little St John Street

All westbound traffic must use the diversionary route

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

HOB LANE, IN THE PARISH OF DUNHAM ON THE HILL IN CHESTER

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of road, in the Parish of Dunham on the Hill, in Chester to enable Centurion Site Services Ltd to carry out railway bridge repairs.

Hob Lane, Dunham on the Hill, between the junctions of Chester Road A56 to Ince Lane B5132

The works are due to commence on Monday 6 December 2010 and are expected to last for 13 nights, with work taking place between 22.00 hrs and 06.00 hrs.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to the lengths of road or in connection with agriculture, building construction, works of repair and the like or use in an emergency of vehicles for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes. A through route will not always be available and any vehicles not requiring access to properties on the length of road should use alternative routes.

The Order will come into force on Monday 6 December 2010 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately two weeks to complete.

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

VARIOUS ROADS IN CHESTER

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of road, in Chester to enable Cheshire West and Chester Council carry out carriageway resurfacing.

(1) Hoole Road, from the Chester side of Brook Street Bridge to The Beehive Public House

(2) Ermine Road from the junction of Hoole Road to a point 50m from the junction

(3) Lightfoot Street from the junction of Hoole Road to a point 50m from the junction

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to the lengths of road or in connection with agriculture, building construction, works of repair and the like or use in an emergency of vehicles for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes. A through route will not always be available and any vehicles not requiring access to properties on the length of road should use the alternative routes.

The Order will come into force on Saturday 30 October 2010 at 1800 hrs and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately five days to complete.

(1) A41 Ring Road, A5115 Whitchurch Road, Christleton Road, A51 Boughton, St Oswald's Way and Hoole Way

(2) Brook Lane, Newton Lane and Hoole Road, A41 Ring Road, A5115 Whitchurch Road, Christleton Road, A51 Boughton, St Oswald's Way and Hoole Way

(3) Hoole Lane, A51 Boughton, St Oswald's Way and Hoole Way
