Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic

Various Roads In Chester

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following lengths of road, in Chester to enable Cheshire West and Chester Council to carry out footway widening and resurfacing and carriageway resurfacing.

1. Bridge Street from its junction with Pepper Street to Pedestrian area (closure & one way restriction)

Road will be closed to vehicular traffic from Monday to Sunday between the hours of 10.30 - 16.30 daily. Road will only be open to vehicular traffic travelling in a northbound direction from Pepper Street to The Cross at all other times.

2. Whitefriars from its junction with Weaver Street to its junction with Bridge Street (one way restriction)

Traffic will only be permitted to travel along Whitefriars in a west bound direction from Bridge Street to Weaver Street.

The Order will come into force on Monday 17 January 2011 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately ten weeks to complete.

Alternative routes for through traffic

Traffic should proceed via Weaver Street, Cuppin Street, Nicholas Street, Grosvenor Street.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF TAXI RANK BRIDGE STREET IN CHESTER

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily suspend the taxi rank on the following length of road, in Chester to enable Cheshire West and Chester Council carry out footway widening and resurfacing and carriageway resurfacing works.

1. Bridge Street Taxi Rank situated 13m north from the centre of White Friars suspended between 10.30hrs and 16.30hrs Monday to Sunday.

A temporary taxi rank will be sited at a point 55m north from the centre of White Friars from 16.30hrs to 05.00hrs Monday to Sunday when road works prevent access to permanent taxi rank.

The Order will come into force on Monday 17 January 2011 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately ten weeks to complete.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

GREEN LANE IN THE PARISH OF GREAT BOUGHTON IN CHESTER

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of road, in the Parish of Great Boughton in Chester to enable North West Gas Alliance to carry out gas main replacement works.

1. Northbound carriageway of Green Lane, Vicars Cross from its junction with A51 Vicars Cross Road to its junction with Melrose Avenue.

The Order will come into force on Saturday 29 January 2011 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately four weeks to complete.

Alternative routes for through traffic

All northbound traffic should proceed via A51 Vicars Cross Road, A41 Ring Road and Green Lane.
