## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

### **TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC**

#### **GREEN LANE IN THE PARISH OF GREAT BOUGHTON IN CHESTER**

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of road, in the Parish of Great Boughton in Chester to enable North West Gas Alliance to carry out gas main replacement works.

- (1) Northbound carriageway of Green Lane, Vicars Cross from its junction with A51 Vicars Cross Road to its junction with Melrose Avenue.

The Order will come into force on Saturday 29 January 2011 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately four weeks to complete.

#### **Alternative routes for through traffic**

All northbound traffic should proceed via A51 Vicars Cross Road, A41 Ring Road and Green Lane.

### **TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2010**

#### **THE GROVES IN CHESTER**

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intend to make an Order to enable Cheshire West and Chester Council to carry out highway improvement works the effect of which will be as follows:

- (1) To prohibit waiting at all times for all drivers (including deliveries) from opposite 14 City Walls (adjacent to access of Roman Gardens) to end of cul-de-sac
- (2) To prohibit waiting from time to time as indicated by traffic signs from the head of the cul-de-sac and the bandstand area

The Order will come into force on Monday 31 January 2011 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately twelve weeks to complete.
