# THE A55 TRUNK ROAD (EASTBOUND CARRIAGEWAY LAY-BY, RHUALLT, DENBIGHSHIRE) (PROHIBITION OF ENTRY TO VEHICLES) ORDER 201-

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Welsh Ministers propose to make an Order under Sections 1 (1), 2 (1) and (2) and 124 of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit vehicles, with the exception of authorised vehicles, from entering the lay-by described in the Schedule to this Notice and to revoke, insofar as it relates to the length of trunk road described in the Schedule to this Notice, The A55 Trunk Road (Various Lay-bys, Rhualt – Travellers' Inn, Clwyd) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1993.

During a period of 21 days from 28 October 2010, a copy of the proposed Order, together with a relevant plan, Statement of Reasons for the making of the Order and the Order being partially revoked may be inspected free of charge during normal opening hours at North Wales Trunk Road Agency, Unit 91, Bowen Court, Ffordd William Morgan, St Asaph Business Park, St Asaph, Denbighshire LL17 0JE or may be obtained free of charge from the address below.

Objections specifying the grounds on which they are made must be made in writing to the Welsh Assembly Government, Transport, Housing and Regeneration, Transport Planning and Governance Division 3, Orders Branch, Cathays Park, Cardiff by 17 November 2010. Should you wish to object, support or make representations, we may need to consult with people and organisations outside the Welsh Assembly Government. As part of the process of consulting with others we may pass information to them, including information you have given us and your personal data. We will however, only disclose your personal details where it is necessary to do so to enable us to deal with issues you have brought to our attention.
