Y llwybr gwahanol sydd ar gael ar gyfer traffig fydd drwy Stryd y Dyffryn, yr A543 Ffordd Rhuthun a Stryd y Parc a bydd wedi ei arwyddo felly. Fe gynhelir mynediad i gerddwyr drwy gydol cyfnod y cau.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order which prohibits any vehicle from using Hall Square Denbigh, in the County of Denbigh, from its junction with Vale Street to its junction with Park Street and Bull Lane

The reason for the closure is to facilitate gas mains replacement works by Wales & West Utilities.

The alternative route available for traffic will be via, Vale Street, A543 Ruthin Road and Park Street and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The existing one-way traffic order on Park Street will be suspended during the period of the closure.

The Order comes into force on Tuesday 4th January 2011, and will remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 8 weeks to complete

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 23rd December 2010 to make an Order which will prohibit any vehicle from using that length of Station Road Glyndyfrdwy, in the County of Denbigh, for its entire length.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate drainage works and resurfacing by Denbighshire County council - Drainage and Maintenance

The alternative route available for traffic will be via, A5, B5437, to Carrog junction to Coed lal junction and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order will come into force on Monday 10th January, 2010 and remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier.
