ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order which prohibits any vehicle from using that length of Station Road Glyndyfrdwy in the County of Denbigh for its entire length.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate drainage works and resurfacing by Denbighshire County Council - Drainage & Maintenance.

The alternative route available for traffic is via A5, B5437 Carrog junction to Coed lal and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order comes into force on Monday January 10th 2011, and will remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier.

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order which prohibits any vehicle from using that length of Broom Hill Lane Denbigh in the County of Denbigh for its entire length to the junction with Tan y Gwalia in and easterly direction for a distance of 40 metres

The reason for the closure is to facilitate a new gas main by Wales & West Utilities

The alternative route available for traffic will be via Ffordd Tynewydd, Bull Lane, Hall Square, High Street, Smithfield Road, and Castle Lane and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order comes into force on 10th January 2011, and will remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 11 weeks to complete
