Traffic Regulation Orders

NOTICE is hereby given that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council proposes to make the following Traffic Regulation Orders in accordance with the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (A5117/ A5032 Little Stanney) (Speed Limit and De-Restriction) Order 2010

The effect of the Order will be to introduce:

1. A 50 mph speed limit on the A5117 from a point 254 metres east of its junction with the A5032 Whitby Lane/Chester Road to a point 36 metres west of its junction with the M53 Junction 10/Stanney Mill Road, Little Stanney, a distance of approximately 1988 metres.
2. A 30 mph speed limit on
 - A5117 from a point 120 metres west of its junction with the A5032 Whitby Lane/ Chester Road to a point 254 east of the junction, a distance of approximately 434 metres.
 - A5032 Whitby Lane from its junction with the A5117 for a distance of 225 metres in a southerly direction.
3. De-restrict a length of the A5117 from a point 36 metres west of its junction with the M53 Junction 10/ Stanney Mill Road to a point 243 metres east of that junction a distance of approximately 465 metres.

The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (A5117/ B5132 Kinsey Road, Little Stanney) (Prohibition of U-Turn) Order 2010

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit u- turns:

1. From the west-bound to east-bound carriageway of the A5117 at its junction of the B5132 Kinsey Road.
2. From the south-bound to north-bound carriageway of the B5132 Kinsey Road at its junction with the A5117.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Order which, together with plans showing the extent of the proposals may be examined at the Parking Services Office, 1st Floor, The Forum, Chester and at the Council Offices, 4 Civic Way, Ellesmere Port between the hours of 9am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday.

If you wish to object to any of the proposed Orders, or to any provisions contained in them, you may do so in writing specifying the grounds on which it is made, to the undersigned by 24 December 2010.
