Mae CynGOR Sir Ddinbych wedi gwneud Gorchymyn a fydd yn gwahardd unrhyw gerbyd rhag defnyddio'r hyd hwnnw o Dan yr Eglwys Rhuddlan yn Sir Ddinbych, sy'n ymestyn o'i gyffordd â Station Road i gyfeiriad y gogledd orllewin am bellter o oddeutu 252 metr.

Y rheswm am y cau yw hwyluso gwaith ail-wynebu'r ffordd gerbydau gan Gyngor Sir Ddinbych - Cynnal.

Y llwybr gwahanol ar gyfer traffig fydd ar hyd Church Street a Station Road ac fe fydd wedi ei arwyddo i'r perwyl hwnnw. Fe gynhelir mynediad i gerddwyr drwy gydol cyfnod y cau.

Fe ddaw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar ddydd Llun Rhagfyr 6ed, 2010 a bydd yn dal mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd gwblhau'r gwaith pa un bynnag yw'r cynharaf. Rhagwelir y bydd y gwaith yn cymryd oddeutu 7 wythnos i'w gwblhau.

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order which prohibits any vehicle from using that length of Tan yr Eglwys Rhuddlan in the County of Denbigh which extends from its junction with Station Road in a north westerly direction for a distance of 252 metres

The reason for the closure is to facilitate resurfacing work by Denbighshire County Council - Maintenance.

The alternative route available for traffic is via Church Street and Station Road and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order comes into force on Monday 6th December 2010, and will remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 7 weeks to complete
