Temporary One Way Order

**Wellington Road/Wellington Road North
in Ellesmere Port**

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of road, in Ellesmere Port to enable gas mains replacement works to be carried out by Balfour Beatty Utility Solutions.

- (1) Wellington Road North from its junction with Cromwell Road to the junction of Cambridge Road. Traffic will be prohibited from travelling in a northerly direction.
- (2) Wellington Road from its junction with Stanney Lane to the junction of Civic Way. Traffic will be prohibited from travelling in a south westerly direction.

The Order will come into force on Monday 9 January 2012 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 4 weeks to complete.

Alternative routes for through traffic

Traffic should proceed via

- 1) Cambridge Road, A5032 Whitby Road and Cromwell Road
- 2) Civic Way, A5032 Whitby Road and Stanney Lane

All vehicles must use the diversionary route.
