Register of Electors – Verification Number

In accordance with The Local Authorities (Referendums) (Petitions and Directions) (England) (Amendment) (No 3) Regulations 2001, the Authority is required to publish the number that is equal to 5% of the number of local government electors for the Authority's area, as shown in the Electoral Register in force as at 1 February 2012.

That number is: 12,559.

This is the number of local government electors required in order to petition the Authority before 1st April 2013, to hold a referendum on whether the Constitution of the Council should provide for the election of a Mayor.

Notice will be given in February 2013 of the number of local government electors required to enable a valid petition to be presented after 31st March 2013 and before 1st April 2014. In the event of the number published in February 2013 being less than the number recently published, then the smaller number will be used for verifying a petition submitted after the date of publication and before 1st April 2013.
