Traffic Regulation Orders

Notice is hereby given that on the 28th day of February 2012 Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council made the following Traffic Regulation Order in accordance with the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which will come into force on 2nd March 2012.

(Weston Grove Area, Upton) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2012

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:

- Gatesheath Drive (both sides) – from its junction with Weston Grove for a distance of 15 metres in a westerly direction
- Newhall Road (both sides) – from its junction with Weston Grove for a distance of 60 metres in a southerly direction
- Weston Grove (westerly side) – from a point 20 metres south of the centre line of Gatesheath Drive to a point 20 metres north of the centre line of Gatesheath Drive
- Weston Grove (easterly side) – from a point 20 metres north-east of the centre line of Newhall Road to a point 62 metres south-west of the centre line of Newhall Road

The Order will also consolidate existing waiting restrictions

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or to any provisions contained in it, on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instruments made under it have not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from 28 February 2012 apply to the High Court for that purpose.
