Traffic Regulation Orders

Notice is hereby given that on 6th March 2012 Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council made the following Traffic Regulation Order in accordance with the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which will come into force on 13th March 2012.

(A51 Duddon Road/High Street, Clotton and A51 Tarporley Road/Duddon Road, Duddon) (Speed Limits) Order 2012

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a 30 mph speed limit on the following lengths of road:

- A51 Duddon Road/High Street, Clotton – from a point 70 metres west of its junction with Willington Lane to a point 473 metres east of its junction with Corkscrew Lane, a distance of approximately 695 metres.
- A51 Tarporley/Duddon Road, Duddon – from a point 34 metres west of its junction with Mill Lane to a point 68 metres east of its junction with Yew Tree Bank, a distance of approximately 1153 metres.

The Order will also consolidate an existing speed limit.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or to any provisions contained in it, on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instruments made under it have not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from 6 March 2012 apply to the High Court for that purpose.
