Notice is hereby given that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council proposes to make the following Traffic Regulation Order in accordance with the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council

(Neston Road, Burton) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2012

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a 30 mph speed limit on Neston Road from the point of the existing 30mph speed limit o/s Woodlands to a point o/s Greenacres Stables, a distance of approximately 275 metres, in essence extending the existing 30mph speed limit in a northerly direction.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a plan showing the extent of the proposal may be examined at the Council Highways Office, Guilden Sutton Depot, Guilden Sutton Lane, Guilden Sutton, Chester or Neston Town Hall, High Street, Neston between the hours of 9am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday.

(Neston Road, Burton/Ness) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2012

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a 40 mph speed limit on Neston Road from a point o/s Greenacres Stables to the existing 30mph speed limit at a point 250m north of Haddon Lane, a distance of approximately 900 metres.
