Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic A5104 Chester Street in Chester

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit and restrict traffic on the following lengths of road, in Chester to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council.

- (1) A5104 Chester Street, Cheshire and Flintshire Boundary at River Lane Junction Saltney up to St. Marks Road, Chester and will also be restricted by a 20mph speed limit – Note that other side road junctions to be closed: Shrewsbury Way, Curzon Street and St. Marks Road (for the full duration) and River Lane and Boundary Lane (for approximately the last three days).

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to the lengths of road or in connection with agriculture, building construction, works of repair and the like or use in an emergency of vehicles for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes. A through route will not always be available and any vehicles not requiring access to properties on the length of road should use the alternative routes.

The Order will come into force on Tuesday 10 April 2012 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately six days to complete.

Alternative routes for through traffic

Traffic should proceed via the following:

For first 3 days traffic heading into Chester will have entry however the exit from Chester will remain closed with the diversion route in place.

For the last 3 days there will be a full closure with 'no through route'.

Diversion route: from Overleigh Roundabout Chester along the A483 to the A55/A483 Post House Roundabout take the A55 North Wales exit to the Broughton Slip Road back to the Broughton Roundabout where the diversion ends (and vice versa).
