Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Temporary Prohibition of Traffic

Various Roads in Ellesmere Port

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following lengths of road, in Ellesmere Port to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council.

(1) B5132 Kinsey Road/Stanney Lane between junction with A5117 Ring Road and northerly access to UCE Academy, Stanney Lane (various sections including roundabouts). Also, B5132 Longlooms Road between A5117 Ring Road junction with B5132 Stanney Lane, including Stanney Woods Avenue to Stanney Woods Avenue Roundabout (at entrance to new M&S store).

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to the lengths of road or in connection with agriculture, building construction, works of repair and the like or use in an emergency of vehicles for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes. A through route will not always be available and any vehicles not requiring access to properties on the length of road should use the alternative routes.

The Order will come into force on Tuesday 8th May 2012 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately four weeks to complete.

Alternative routes for through traffic

Traffic should proceed via the following:

Phase 1 (overnight works, 3 nights) – B5132 Kinsey Road closed between A5117 junction and Sainsburys Roundabout (including Sainsburys roundabout and access to the Sainsburys petrol station and access to The Millstone); diversion via A5117 and B5132 Longlooms Road and vice versa.

Phase 1a (daytime works, 2-3 days) – B5132 Kinsey Road closed between Sainsburys Roundabout and Stanney Lane Roundabout (junction with Coliseum Way / Longlooms Road), both carriageways, including junctions with Cheshire Oaks Service Road and UV 2806 Stanney Lane; diversion via A5117 and B5132 Longlooms Road and vice versa.

Phase 2 (overnight works, 3 nights) – B5132 Longlooms Road closed between B5132 Stanney Lane Roundabout and A5117; including B5132 Stanney Lane Roundabout and junctions with B5132 Stanney Lane / Kinsey Road and Coliseum Way; and B5132 Business Park Roundabout, Longlooms Road, including Stanney Woods Avenue to Stanney Woods Avenue Roundabout (at entrance to new M&S store). Diversion via B5132 Stanney Lane, Underwood Drive, Woodland Road, A5032 Chester Road, A5117 Ring Road and B5132 Kinsey Road. Access to/from Coliseum Way via Cheshire Oaks Way.

Phase 3 (daytime works, 2-3 days) – B5132 Longlooms Road closed between A5117 Ring Road and Business Park Roundabout, including alternating partial closures of A5117 roundabout. Traffic on A5117 to proceed under traffic signal control. Diversion route via A5117 Ring Road, B5132 Kinsey Road and B5132 Longlooms Road and vice versa.

Phase 4 (daytime works, 4 days) – B5132 Stanney Lane closed between Stanney Lane Roundabout and northerly access to UCE Academy, including junction with Dover Drive and southerly access to UCE Academy. Diversion via B5132 Stanney Lane, Underwood Drive, Woodland Road, A5032 Chester Road, A5117 Ring Road and B5132 Longlooms Road and vice versa. Access to UCE Academy and David Lloyd sports centre to be maintained.
