

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 -
SECTION 14 THE A494 TRUNK ROAD (DEESIDE
PARK) (WESTBOUND ENTRY SLIP ROAD FROM
THE A540 PARKGATE ROAD)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2012**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order on the A494 Trunk Road in Cheshire West and Chester to enable carriageway surfacing works to be carried out in safety.

The works are expected to take place overnight between 2200 hours and 0500 starting on Wednesday 23 May 2012 and ending on Thursday 24 May 2012. However, if necessary, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed.

The Order will ban all traffic from:

- i. the A494 westbound entry slip road from the A540 Parkgate Road; and
- ii. the layby adjacent to the A494 eastbound carriageway at a point 220 metres east of the centreline of Woodbank Lane overbridge.

Traffic wishing to join the A494 westbound carriageway from the A540 Parkgate Road will be directed to continue northbound on Parkgate Road, turn left at the junction at Two Mills and travel on the A550 southbound to join the A494.

Traffic signs will indicate the extent of the prohibitions. The prohibition banning all traffic from the A494 westbound entry slip road from the A540 Parkgate Road will include vehicles being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue, ambulance services and traffic officers.
