

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 -SECTION 14 THE M56 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 16, EASTBOUND ENTRY SLIP ROAD) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2012

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order on the M56 Motorway in Cheshire East to enable electrical loop replacement works to be carried out in safety.

The works are expected to take place overnight between 2200 hours and 0500 hours starting on Wednesday 20 June 2012 and ending on Thursday 21 June 2012. However, if necessary, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed.

The Order will ban all traffic from the M56 eastbound entry slip road at Junction 16.

Traffic wishing to join the M56 eastbound at Junction 16 from the A5117 at Parkgate will be directed to continue on the A5117 eastbound to join the M53 southbound at Junction 10. Traffic will then travel southbound to access the M56 eastbound via the link road at Junction 15.

The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as will be indicated by traffic signs and will not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the works or by traffic officers, or to vehicles being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services.
