

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
THE A483 TRUNK ROAD (MAESBURY ROAD
JUNCTION, OSWESTRY, SHROPSHIRE) (50 MILES
PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20XX**

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that she intends to make an Order under section 84(1)(a) and (2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A483 Trunk Road at Oswestry in the County of Shropshire.

The effect of the order would be to impose a 50 miles per hour speed limit on the A483 between points 585 metres southwest and 412 metres northeast of its northern junction with Maesbury Road.

A copy of the draft Order, together with plans illustrating the proposals, a copy of the order to be revoked and a Statement of the Secretary of State's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected during opening hours at Shropshire County Council, Traffic Management (Development Services), Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury, SY2 6ND; Oswestry Library, Arthur Street, Oswestry, Shropshire, SY11 1JN or may be seen at, or obtained by application to, the Highways Agency, The Cube, 199 Wharfside Street, Birmingham, B1 1RN.

Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order should send a written statement of their objection and the grounds thereof to Karen Eustace at the Highways Agency at the address given above. The objection must be received no later than 2 August 2012 .
