

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984-SECTION 14(1)(A) THE A5 TRUNK ROAD (GOBOWEN, SHROPSHIRE) (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION AND PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2012

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport intends to make an Order on the A5 Trunk Road, near Gobowen in the County of Shropshire, to allow resurfacing and lining work to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to-

1. impose a 40 miles per hour speed restriction on the northbound carriageway of the A5 between points 415 metres south and 390 metres north of its junction with the road leading to Hengoed at Pleasant Groves; and
2. prohibit vehicles from entering or leaving the A5 at its junction with Pleasant Groves.

The work will be carried out over four nights between 19:00 hours and 06:30 hours and is expected to start Monday 13 August 2012. The Order will come into force on 6 August 2012.

Vehicles being used by special forces will be exempt from the speed restriction. Vehicles being used by the emergency services will be exempt from the speed restriction and prohibition. Vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the prohibition. During the side road closure a local diversion route will operate.
