Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Traffic City Walls in Chester

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the following length of footway in Chester, to enable repair and improvement works to be carried out by Cheshire West and Chester Council.

- (1) City Walls footpath between Newgate Bridge and St John Street steps, near to Wesley Church FP068/118/1 and FX362.

The Order will come into force on Monday 10th September 2012 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately one month to complete.

Alternative routes for through traffic

The diversionary route is via St John Street and Little John Street
