

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
THE A483 TRUNK ROAD (MAESBURY ROAD
JUNCTION, OSWESTRY, SHROPSHIRE)
(50 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2012**

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 84(1)(a) and (2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A483 Trunk Road at Oswestry in the County of Shropshire.

The effect of the order, which comes into force on 14 December 2012, will be to impose a 50 miles per hour speed limit on the A483 between points 585 metres southwest and 412 metres northeast of its northern junction with Maesbury Road.
