

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 –
SECTION 14(1)(A)
THE A483 TRUNK ROAD (SOUTH EAST OF
OSWESTRY, SHROPSHIRE) (TEMPORARY
PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2012**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport intends to make an Order on the A483 Trunk Road south east of Oswestry in the County of Shropshire, to allow resurfacing and associated work to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to –

- (a) impose a 40 miles per hour speed restriction on the A483 between its roundabout junction with the A5 and the B4579 (Mile End Roundabout) and its junction with the B5069;
- (b) close the length of A483 described at (a) above; and
- (c) close any layby adjacent to the length of A483 described at (a) above.

The work will be carried out over four nights between 20:00 hours and 07:00 hours and is expected to start on Monday 14 January 2013. The Order will come into force on 7 January 2013.

Vehicles being used by the Special Forces will be exempt from the speed restriction. Vehicles being used by the emergency services will be exempt from the speed restriction and the closures and vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the closures. Access to property will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes using the A5 and A458 and vice versa will be well signed.
