

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 –
SECTION 14(1)(A)
THE A483 TRUNK ROAD (SHROPSHIRE)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2013**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order on the A483 Trunk Road, in the County of Shropshire, to allow resurfacing work to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to –

- (1) close the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A483 from its roundabout junction with the A5 and B4579 (Mile End Roundabout) to a point 40 metres south of the centreline of its junction with the unnamed road leading to Pen Y Foel north of Llanymynech (Welsh Border); and
- (2) prohibit vehicles from entering or leaving length of trunk road described in (1) above at its junction with –
 - (a) the unnamed road leading to Hazel Grove 452 metres south of its junction with the B5069;
 - (b) Albridge Lane;
 - (c) Church Lane;
 - (d) the B4396;
 - (e) the A495;
 - (f) Penygarreg Lane;
 - (g) Station Road (north);
 - (h) Station Road (south);
 - (i) Briggs Lane;
 - (j) Stargarreg Lane; and
 - (k) Rhew Level Lane.

The work is expected to start at 00.01 hours on Monday 4 March 2013 and continue for approximately three weeks. The Order will come into force on 25 February 2013.

Vehicles being used by the emergency services and vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the closure and prohibition. A diversion route via the A458 and A5 and vice versa will be well signed.
