Notice of application for a full licence to abstract water

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Section 37 of the Water Resources Act 1991 and Regulation 6 of the Water Resources (Abstraction and Impounding) Regulations 2006 that an application has been made to Natural Resources Wales by Infinis Wind Holdings Limited for a full licence to abstract water from the Afon Claerwen, near Rhayader at National Grid Reference SN 88350 62780.

The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates and periods:

13,320 cubic metres an hour,

319,680 cubic metres a day and

116,683,200 cubic metres a year

all year.

The water will be used for hydroelectric power generation. All abstracted water will be returned to the Afon Claerwen at National Grid Reference SN 89590 61840.

A copy of the application, map, plan and any other document submitted with it may be inspected free of charge at the address of Natural Resources Wales at Ladywell House, Park Street, Newtown, SY16 1RD during normal office hours (Monday-Friday, except bank holidays).
