Defnyddir y dŵr at ddibenion cynhyrchu trydan dŵr.

Dychwelir yr holl ddŵr a dynnir i Nant Teflyn yng Nghyfeirnod Grid Cenedlaethol SN 99532 62886.

Gwneir cais hefyd am drwydded i atal neu rwystro llif Nant Treflyn yng Nghyfeirnod Grid Cenedlaethol SH 99608 62912. Diben cronni dŵr trwy gyfrwng y gwaith yw llunio cored newydd ar gyfer creu digon o ddyfnder dŵr ar gyfer tynnu.

Notice of application for a full licence to abstract water and for a licence to obstruct or impede the flow of an inland water by means of impounding works

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Section 37 of the Water Resources Act 1991 and Regulation 6 of the Water Resources (Abstraction and Impounding) Regulations 2006 that an application has been made to Natural Resources Wales by David Julian Gibson Watt for a full licence to abstract water from the Nant Treflyn at Argoed near Llandrindod Wells, Powys at National Grid Reference SN 99608 62912.

The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates and periods:

1,116 cubic metres an hour,

26,784 cubic metres a day and

7,820,928 cubic metres a year.

The water will be used for hydroelectric power generation.

All abstracted water will be returned to the Nant Treflyn at National Grid Reference SN 99532 62886.

Application is also being made for a licence to obstruct or impede the flow of the Nant Treflyn at National Grid Reference SN 99608 62912. The object of impounding water by means of the works is to build a new weir to create a head for abstraction.

A copy of the applications, maps, plans and any other document submitted with it may be inspected free of charge at the address of Natural Resources Wales, Powells Place, Powells Lane, Welshpool, Powys, SY21 7JY during normal office hours (Monday-Friday, except bank holidays).
