NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC  
ORDER  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order which prohibits any vehicle from using that length of that length of unclassified road from Liver Cottage to Plas Newydd junction Bryneglwys in the County of Denbigh.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate the protection of the newly constructed surface of the highway at the southern end including associated drainage, which needs drying out prior to use by motorised traffic.

There is no alternative route available. Access will be maintained throughout the period of closure for pedestrians, cyclists and horse-riders.

The Order comes into force on 8th May 2014, and will remain in force for a period of eighteen months. It is anticipated that the road is likely to be closed for approximately 6 months.
