Ar 27 Mawrth 2013 fe gyhoeddodd y Cyngor rybudd o Orchymyn i wahardd unrhyw gerbydau rhag defnyddio'r rhan hynny o'r ffordd ddi-ddosbarth ger Corwen yn Sir Ddinbych sy'n ymestyn o'i gyffordd ag Ucheldref i Waen Fawr ac yn mynd mewn cylch i gyfeiriad de ddwyreiniol am bellter o oddeutu 253 metr.

Y rheswm dros gau'r ffordd yw hwyluso'r gwaith hanfodol mae Energy Alliance angen ei wneud ar geblau trydan uwchben.

Bydd y llwybr teithio arall sydd ar gael i draffig yn mynd trwy Ucheldref i Waen Fawr, a rownd cyffordd Pen y Coed i gyffordd Tyn Celyn a bydd arwyddion i ddangos hynny. Bydd mynediad yn cael ei ganiatáu i gerddwyr yn ystod y cyfnod cau.

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC
ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

On 27th March 2013 the Council published a notice stating that it had made an Order which prohibits any vehicle from using that length of unclassified road near Corwen in the County of Denbigh which extends from its junction with Ucheldref to Waen Fawr and loop in a south easterly direction for a distance of approximately 253 metres.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate essential works to overhead electricity lines by Energy Alliance.

The alternative route available for traffic is via Ucheldref to Waen Fawr and loop, Pen y Coed junction to Tyn Celyn junction and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order came into force on 29th March 2013, for an eighteen month period and it is anticipated that the works will be undertaken during the following time periods which are approximate.
