NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 4th June 2014 to make an Order which will prohibit any vehicle from using that length of Elwy Bridge, High Street, St. Asaph, in the County of Denbigh for its entire length.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate the construction of an access platform by Denbighshire County Council – Bridges Section.

Alternative routes are available for traffic as stated below which will be sign-posted accordingly, pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

- 1) Chester Street, A55 and A525 The Roe
- 2) B5381 Lower Denbigh Road, Allt Goch, A525 St. Asaph Road, A525 Upper Denbigh Road.

The Order will come into force on Sunday 22nd June 2014 and remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will be undertaken on the following dates which are subject to change at short notice.

- Sunday 22nd June 2014 from 19:00hrs to 05:00hrs on Monday 23rd June 2014
- Saturday 28th June 2014 from 19:00hrs to 05:00 on Monday 30th June 2014
