**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 4th June 2014 to make an Order which will prohibit any vehicle from using that length of Tyn y Cefn Road Corwen in the County of Denbigh for its entire length.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate bridge replacement works by Denbighshire County Council - Bridges Section.

There is no alternative route available. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order will come into force on 24th June 2014 and remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 4 weeks to complete.
