COMPULSORY PURCHASE OF LAND IN DENBIGH**

1. Notice is hereby given that the Denbighshire County Council has made the Denbighshire County Council (Denbigh Hospital) Compulsory Purchase Order 2014 under section 47 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990. It is about to submit this Order to the Welsh Ministers for confirmation and, if confirmed, the Order will authorise Denbighshire County Council to purchase compulsorily the land described below for the purpose of ensuring that reasonable steps are taken for properly preserving a listed building.
2. A copy of the Order and of the accompanying map may be seen at all reasonable hours at County Hall, Wynnstay Road, Ruthin LL15 1YN.
3. Any objection to the Order must be made in writing to the Welsh Ministers before 30 September 2014 and state the title of the Order, the grounds of objection and the objector's address and interests in the land. (The address to which objections should be sent is The Planning Inspectorate, PINS 3, Government Building, Cathays Park, Cardiff, CF10 3NQ)
