Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych wedi gwneud Gorchymyn sy'n gwahardd unrhyw gerbyd rhag teithio ar hyd y darn hwnnw o'r B5429 Croesffyrdd Llysfasi hyd at Graigfechan ym Mhentrecelyn, Sir Ddinbych, sy'n ymestyn o'i gyffordd â'r A525 am bellter o oddeutu 561 metr i'r gogledd ddwyrain.

Mae angen cau'r ffordd er mwyn galluogi Gallagher Construction i osod dwythell BT.

Bydd y llwybr teithio arall sydd ar gael i drafnidiaeth yn mynd ar hyd y B5429 Llanfair DC i'r B5429 Ffolt, a'r A525 a bydd arwyddion wedi eu gosod i ddangos hynny. Bydd mynediad i gerddwyr yn cael ei gynnal drwy gydol y cyfnod cau.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ddydd Sadwrn 19 Gorffennaf 2014, a bydd yn para am 18 mis neu tan y bydd y gwaith wedi ei gwblhau, pa un bynnag sydd gyntaf. Disgwylir i'r gwaith gymryd oddeutu 2 wythnos i'w gwblhau.

**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order which prohibits any vehicle from using that length of B5429 Llysfasi Crossroads to Graigfechan at Pentrecelyn, in the County of Denbigh which extends from its junction with A525 in a north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 561 metres.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate the installation of a BT duct by Gallagher Construction.

The alternative route available for traffic is via B5429, Llanfair DC to B5429 Ffolt, and A525 and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order comes into force on Saturday 19th July 2014, and will remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take 2 weeks to complete.
