Y rheswm dros gau'r ffordd yw hwyluso'r gwaith o ddatblygu man gwyrdd agored fel rhan o Brosiect Gwella Tai Gorllewin Rhyll gan Ddatblygiad Economaidd a Busnes Cyngor Sir Ddinbych.

Y ffordd amgen ar gael i draffig fydd John Street, Rhodfa'r Gorllewin ac Abbey Street a bydd arwyddion i ddangos hynny. Bydd mynediad i gerddwyr yn cael ei gynnal drwy gydol y cyfnod cau.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 4ydd Awst 2014 a bydd yn parhau mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd nes y cwblheir y gwaith, pa un bynnag sydd gynharaf. Disgwylir y bydd y gwaith yn cymryd tuag wyth mis i'w gwblhau.

**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 16th July 2014 to make an Order which will prohibit any vehicle from using the lengths of roads referred to in the Schedule below.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate the development of an open green space as part of the West Rhyll Housing Improvement Project by Denbighshire County Council Economic and Business Development.

The alternative route available for traffic will be via John Street, West Parade, and Abbey Street and will be sign posted accordingly. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The Order will come into force on 4th August 2014 and remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 8 months to complete.

Lengths of Road at Rhyll in the County of Denbigh**

- 1) Gronant Street; for its entire length.
- 2) Aquarium Street from its junction with John Street to its junction with Abbey Street.
