Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych wedi gwneud Gorchymyn a'i effaith yw:-

1) Rhoi terfyn cyflymder 10 milltir yr awr dros dro ar y darn hwnnw o'r ffordd Dosbarth III a elwir yn Pant Du i groesffordd Eryrys, Eryrys, o'i chyffordd â Phreswylfa i gyffordd Graig Goch i gyfeiriad y gogledd-ddwyrain i ffin y sir.

Gweithredir y cyfyngiad 10mya pan fydd gwaith confoi mewn grym ar unrhyw ddiwrnod penodol.

2) Gwahardd pob cerbyd rhag goddiweddyd ar hyd y darn uchod o'r ffordd.

Mae angen y cyfyngiad hwn er diogelwch y gweithwyr sy'n arwynebu'r ffordd ar ran Uned Waith Cyngor Sir Ddinbych.

Daw'r Gorchymyn hwn i rym ar 28 Gorffennaf 2014 a bydd yn parhau mewn grym am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis neu hyd nes y cwblheir y gwaith, pa un bynnag sydd gynharaf. Disgwylir i'r gwaith barhau am oddeutu 2 wythnos.

**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER  
DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
PANT DU TO ERYRYS CROSSROADS, ERYRYS  
NOTICE OF TEMPORARY 10 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION AND NO OVERTAKING  
ORDER  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order the effect of which is :-

1) To impose temporarily a 10 mph speed limit on that length of the Class III road known as Pant Du to Eryrys crossroads, Eryrys, from its junction with Preswylfa to Graig Goch junction in a north easterly direction to the county boundary.

The 10 mph limit will apply when convoy work is in force on any given day.

2) To prohibit all vehicles from overtaking in the said length of road.

The reason for the restriction is to facilitate the safety of workmen during resurfacing works by Denbighshire County Council - Works Unit.

The Order comes into force on 28th July 2014 and remains in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 2 weeks to complete.
