NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE

NOTICE IS GIVEN THAT BCR Restaurants Limited t/a McDonald's has applied to Powys County Council on 30th July 2014 for the variation of a premises licence to use the premises at Pool Road, Cambrian Way, Newtown, SY16 1DG, for provision of late night refreshment for the sale of hot food and drink. The proposed variation is to remove the condition at Annex 2 which reads "Only the 'Drive-Thru' will be open from 23:00 hours until 05:00 hours. Any person who wishes to make a representation in relation to this application must give notice in writing of his/her representation by 27th August 2014 stating the grounds for making said representation to the: Powys County Council, Licensing Team, Neuadd Maldwyn, Severn Road, Welshpool, Powys, SY21 7AS. A record of the application can be inspected at the above address during office hours. Representations must be received by the Licensing Authority by the date given above. The Licensing Authority will have regard to any representation in considering the application that complies with the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003, the Regulations made thereunder and relates to at least one of the licensing objectives, being the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm.

It is an offence, under section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003, to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in or in connection with an application for a premises licence and the maximum fine on being convicted of such an offence is £5,000.
